New trophies for 2025

For its inaugural County Championships in 2002, the Herefordshire Archery Association (having been re-activated only the year before, when its sole existing club Hereford Company of Bowmen was joined by Bromyard Bowmen and three other now-defunct clubs) did not yet have sufficient funds for trophies. However, James Mattock very kindly donated a number that he had in his attic.

Of particular note, a pair of silver quivers bearing the badge of the Mid Hereford & York Round Archery Society (a defunct local archery club), previously used as trophies in the early 1970s, were adopted as the Ladies + Gentlemen Recurve trophies. Others, adopted for Ladies + Gentlemen Compound, for Gentlemen Longbow, and for Juniors, were cups that members of James' family had won for various horticultural accomplishments in the early 20th century. In subsequent years James kindly donated further horticultural cups, adopted for Ladies Longbow and for Junior Compound. Wooden bases were made for each of these, documenting their adoption as championship trophies and providing space to record the winners.

Over the years, two issues arose. First was the recognition that we still lacked trophies for some categories, most notably Barebow. Second, opinions differed on the trophies being used: some appreciated the quality of some rather fine historic cups, but others regarded the use of such unrelated trophies as unsatisfactory.

We eventually decided that we would retain the Ladies + Gentlemen Recurve MHYRAS quivers (the re-use of these historic archery trophies, especially given their quality and local pedigree, was recognized as eminently suitable), but source new / replacement trophies for all other categories. In early 2025, then, Chairman Mark Beaumont worked with a local company who created a set of bespoke trophies, which were awarded for the first time this year.

The junior trophy for each bow type is awarded to the junior making the highest score for the Hereford / Bristol round appropriate to their age group / gender:
